
CAST: Cognitive Assessment and Skills Training

Introduction


CAST is a remedial program for the children who are experiencing difficulties with reading, writing spelling, comprehension and overall cognitive processes. This program can begin at any level as per children's need irrespective of their current age and grade. It provides a supplementary route towards the development of reading and associated academic skills through the development of cognitive processes in as much as these skills are assumed to be part of general cognitive development, and works in the following way:



Who is most likely to benefit from this program?

Children ranging from kindergarten to elder children with or without special needs (like learning disability, slow learner, dyslexia, ADHD, mental retardation, developmental delay, or children having difficulty in phonological coding, or are at risk of developing dyslexia) will be benefitted with this program.

What is the procedure for applying this program?



Duration: 45min - 1hr (per session)

Varies from child to child depending upon his/her understanding level and area of difficulty ranging from minimum 20 sessions to 45 sessions.
